1) A passionate belief in the benefits art education can provide. 2) Education is key to furthering our society. 3) Witnessing students discovering new things about their world or new ways of seeing is the most rewarding experience for a teacher.

How much do you want to know about your students in order to be most helpful to them?

As much as time and appropriateness allows: Personal interests, limitations, strengths, and concerns or insecurities are extremely important factors in how a student will learn, what they will retain, and how what they learn will impact their lives.

What three things do you most want to know about your students?

1) What method of learning works best for them according to their strengths and weaknesses. 2) How do they feel about art (do they enjoy it or are they insecure). 3) What cultural, social, and emotional factors are most affecting their interests.

What do you need to know in order to begin your lesson planning for a class?

Students' interests are paramount in a lesson plan, as are their limitations. If a student's personal life or real-world situations are not addressed in some way during the course of the lesson, he/she will be less likely to fully benefit from it.

What four key components do you believe you must include in your plan?

Lessons should foster cumulative development of cognitive skills (1), a connection between the subject and the students' personal interests (2), real-world situations that students may encounter in the future (3), and the students' other courses (4)

When you think about your students, in what major ways do you most want to influence their lives?

I would like to provide them with problem solving skills, critical thinking skills, and a myriad of other benefits that can be learned through art, so that they may apply them to their core subjects, as well as personal and professional lives.

What two core teaching strategies do you most use to achieve this result?

Create a forum where students can reach conclusions while I facilitate problem solving, instead of providing direct answers. Allow self directed discovery (within parameters) so students can employ self motivation and personalized synthesis of ideas.
